WILDERNESS & REMOTE FIRST AID INSTRUCTOR RECERTIFICATION

Below is the pathway to become a certified Wilderness & Remote First Aid Instructor. You must successfully complete each step before advancing to the next step. Certification is valid for three years.

1 CHECK PREREQUISITES



Confirm prerequisites are met: you must have a current CRC First Aid certification and you must have taught a minimum of one CRC Wilderness & Remote First Aid course in the three-year certification period.

2 DISCIPLINE SPECIFIC CLASSROOM COMPONENT



Attend the discipline-specific classroom components (6 hrs), which focuses on the specific skills of that program.

3 CERTIFICATION



The final step is recertification. Congratulations!
